

Janet Davis's tab for *Autumn Leaves* (part 1) was originally published in *BNL* August 1979 (along with the second, faster section, *Autumn Leaves part 2*). In March 2009 BNL republished the tab for *Autumn Leaves*, part 2 (in Janet Davis's *Back-Up* column entitled "*Autumn Leaves in 'E' Harmonic Minor*") but the first, slower, part was not republished, for reasons of space. Here it is now. You can hear mp3s on the website for both the two parts played together, and the faster, second, part played alone.
